Bird in Hand Pinot Grigio 2022

Adelaide Hills



The Adelaide Hills is renowned for many of Australia's finest white varietals and the cool climate is an ideal environment for producing the Italian style Pinot Grigio.

Pinot gris grapes from a two cool climate sites at Macclesfield and Cuddlee Creek (300-350m altitude) were harvested in the cool of night to ensure extraction of the most vibrant fruit. Majority of the fruit was handpicked and whole bunch pressed while only the free run juice was used to make this delicate wine. It was further left on light lees for 4 weeks to enhance mouthfeel and texture before bottling.

Pale in colour with a green hue, this Pinot Grigio shows bright fragrant aromatics of corella pear, green apple and pretty white blossom. On the palate, the wine is light and crisp with a chalky mineral acidity.

Crisp, fresh and full flavoured, this Pinot Grigio is best enjoyed young. It is a great partner to Italian antipasti and fresh seafood dishes such as crayfish and scallops.
